



RECRUITMENT PROCESS FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Do I need to be vaccinated for Covid-19 if I'm not applying for a direct patient-contact position?

Yes, Covid-19 vaccinations are required for all healthcare organization employees per state mandate. Governor Inslee's mandate requires for all Washington healthcare workers to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 or have an approved medical or religious exemption by October 18th, 2021. This would require you to receive a J&J vaccine or the second dose of the Moderna or Pfizer vaccines on or before 10/4/21. You would not be able to start working in any position until you are fully vaccinated.

I've applied for a position with UCNW. What happens next?

What is your recruitment process?

At UCNW, we take pride in completing a comprehensive recruitment process, as we are devoted to building a positive work environment populated with talented, dedicated professionals to join us in our efforts to fulfill our organization's mission, vision & values. We appreciate all who participate in our selection process as we know your time is valuable.

If you're selected to move forward in our recruitment process after submitting your applications materials, here's what you can expect:

Step One - Phone Interview with our Recruiter or an HR Generalist

During this interview, we will explore your qualifications and motivations along with your employment history and availability. In addition, we will share details about UCNW and the position you've applied for. Our phone interviews usually take 45 minutes to an hour.

*Please note that if you don't live in Bellingham, the hiring manager may perform a 2nd phone interview to assess your technical skills before inviting you for an On-Site Visit.

Step Two – An On-site Visit

If you are selected as a top candidate, we will move forward with an On-Site visit that will include a more comprehensive interview with our hiring panel. During these site visits you may also meet the team, see the work area and/or spend time job shadowing. On-Site Visits vary in length depending on the position and may sometimes take a couple weeks to schedule because we do our best not to impact our patients' access to care.

*Please note, due to the COVID-19 pandemic some of these steps may be performed virtually via Zoom or other platform.

Step Three - Skills Testing & Reference Checks

If there are any skills tests applicable to the position for which you're interviewing, the Recruiter will send them to you when scheduling the On-Site Visit. If you remain a top candidate during the interview stage please be prepared to invite your references to complete an online questionnaire by gathering their email addresses.

Upon completion of a successful recruitment we will notify all applicants of their status and that the job has been filled.
